



Visitor Restrictions

Due to the high number of flu cases in Illinois, Delnor Hospital is taking steps to protect our patients, their families and staff by temporarily limiting visitation. Patients and family members have expressed appreciation that Delnor is providing the appropriate due diligence with this serious situation.

In order to reduce the spread of influenza within Delnor Hospital, we are strongly recommending the following to protect our patients' health:

- Anyone who is ill should not visit a patient in the hospital.
- Visitors should follow proper hand and respiratory hygiene at all times.
- Visitors should wash hands or use alcohol-based hand sanitizer upon entering and leaving a patient room.
- Visitors should follow isolation precautions as directed by the facility.
- Visitors are limited to only those people essential to the well being of the patient.
- The number of visitors per patient is no more than 2 visitors at a time.
- It is strongly recommended that anyone, who may have been exposed to influenza refrain from visiting, such as:
 - All children 18 years and under.
 - Those who have had recent contact with someone who has had an influenza-like illness.

We appreciate your cooperation and we will return to our open visitation hours as soon as we are assured that it is in the best interest of our patients.
